SATOP

Almost everybody who gets a DWI will have to take a SATOP class. SATOP stands for Substance Abuse Traffic Offenders Program. According to figures from the Missouri Department of Mental Health, Division of Alcohol and Drug Abuse, SATOP serves more than 30,000 DWI offenders annually who are referred as a result of an administrative suspension or revocation of their driver licenses, court order, condition of probation, or plea bargain. If your driver's license is suspended or revoked as a result of a DWI, you are required, by law, to attend SATOP as a requirement in driver's license reinstatement by the Department of Revenue.

It is good to get started on SATOP classes right away. Getting your license back, in case you are suspended, is going to depend on completing SATOP. Also, the SATOP license reinstatement process can be tiresome. After completing your initial screening process (which everyone who is arrested for DWI is required to take), you are placed in the appropriate level of SATOP. The multi-level SATOP services range from a 10-hour Offender Education Program (designed for first-time, or low-risk, offenders) to a 50-hour Clinical Intervention Program (consists of counseling and group education).
